

Your ISTQB Foundation Level Extension Agile Tester Training March 16-17, 2017 at STPCon in Phoenix, AZ

Time is quickly approaching for your ISTQB Foundation Level Extension Agile Tester Training which will be held March 16-17, 2017 at STPCon in Phoenix, AZ. To help you prepare for the course and exam, we are providing you with some important information regarding the course materials and preparations.

E-learning access (login information in a separate email):

You have been given access to the e-learning version of this course. Though it is not required that you complete the e-learning course, we strongly recommend that you do review it as much as possible. We provide complimentary access to be used for study purposes only. You should have received a separate email with your Articulate Online login and password to access the course a few moments ago.

Hard copy course materials:

Your hardcopy materials will be given to you on the first day of the course. The hard copy materials will include the course slides for you to use during class to follow along and jot down notes if you desire.

Downloadable course materials (accessible via your unique link below):

All of our live and virtual course attendees, in addition to their e-learning course and hard copy course materials, receive access to a downloadable copy of the complete note set. You will be able to download the materials to a PC or mobile device. There will be no expiration date on access to this valuable resource as they will be downloadable. Digital rights management and intellectual property rights are protected by some limitations such as the inability to share the file with others. Further, while the materials can be printed, each page includes a prominent watermark, with the exception of the pages in the ISTQB Syllabus and Glossary. The ISTQB Syllabus and Glossary are printable documents available to the public so they will not include the watermark. In fact, we recommend that attendees print those two documents or download them in order to have access to them while you study and for quick reference during class.

The ISTQB Syllabus and Glossary are in separate folders since you have permission to view and print those without a watermark. Podcasts of the audio associated with the e-learning course is available upon request. If you want to download the audio to your phone or mobile device to listen to while away from the computer, let us know.

To provide clarification regarding the downloadable printable material you have access to via your unique link, you can and should download this material as soon as possible to a tablet, a Kindle, a Smartphone, a PC or some other device. These documents were introduced to our repertoire of supplemental materials in order to support our green initiative. Although you will be receiving printed slides during the class, you need to bring your mobile documents to the live class via your device. The documents contain information that will not be in the printed materials. On each morning of the class please be sure that your device is fully charged and accessible!

Please note that the ISTQB currently requires Foundation Level certification in order to sit for the exam (Foundation Level certification is not required to sit for the course). In order to qualify to sit for the exam one must complete the following:

1) Create a profile at the ASTQB Exam Registration Site, if one does not already exist.

2) Then contact ASTQB Headquarters at info@astqb.org so they can verify the CTFL certification and then allow access to the agile exam. Send them your name as it appears on your ASTQB CTFL certificate. (If your CTFL is not from ASTQB, then you must send a copy of your CTFL certificate.)
